

# How far would you walk to save their lives?

## How about 12,523km?!

That's how far a team of Cardiac Specialists will travel again from New Zealand to Zambia in May 2012. They will carry out life saving heart operations on young underprivileged Zambians who have no access to such services at all.

**BUT** we only ask you to **walk 6km around Hagley Park** with us. In so doing, help us raise the funds for this mission and save lives, 12,523km away!

*During the first mission for this project in March 2011, we successfully performed seven life saving heart operations on young Zambian women, who now lead a normal life.*

*For the next mission, we have already raised \$60,000, acquired donated medical supplies and secured the support of the Zambian Government.*

*Our target is \$200,000 and this walk will help get us closer to the goal*

### The Mutima Project aims to:

- Carry out 100 heart operations during five missions over a five year period
- Assist in establishing an independent and sustainable cardiac unit at the University Teaching Hospital, Lusaka during that time by
  - Donating equipment
  - Training doctors and nursing staff
  - Providing specialised advice
